Requirements for candidates:

- citizenship of one of the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, Germany or the former USSR;
- completed doctoral studies;
- thesis defended at a Polish university (regardless of the doctoral student's citizenship) or a thesis of a Polish citizen defended abroad.

Required documents:

- CV including details on education, previous experience, publications, topics of diploma theses and language skills;
- a copy of the diploma/certificate of university education with the academic degree obtained;
- thesis in the field as specified in the rules, written in one of the languages of the above-mentioned countries.

Basic rules:

- 1. The best doctoral thesis competition will be announced annually with the following requirements:
 - a) the thesis was defended up to 3 years before the announcement of the competition;
 - b) only theses defended at Polish universities (regardless of the doctoral student's citizenship) and theses of Polish citizens defended abroad can be submitted to the competition;
- 2. Selection of theses shall be carried out in three stages:
 - 1 formal qualification (2 Committee secretaries);
 - 2 substantive qualification (substantive Committee composed of specialists in the field and topic, the Committee may also order external reviews);
 - 3 final Committee (substantive Committee, secretaries, delegate of the Centre for East European Studies management)

Our offer:

- 1. The author of the winning thesis shall receive a financial prize of PLN 25,000 gross, an Award diploma, and the right to publish the thesis in the Centre for East European Studies series.
- 2. There is also the possibility of awarding 2nd and 3rd prizes (PLN 15 000 gross and PLN 10 000 gross, respectively).
